Directions to the Whidbey Island Pony Club Equestrian Park:

Coming over the bridge?

Take I-5 north to exit #230 (Anacortes/Whidbey Island)

At end of exit ramp turn left and follow Hwy 20 and signs to Oak Harbor

Go thru Oak Harbor and head south to Coupeville. Approx 6 miles

Turn right on Hastie Lake Rd. (just past Boon Rd) follow Hastie Lake Rd across Zylstra Rd and follow to end of road toward the water.

Turn Left on West Beach Rd.

Turn Left on Van Dam Rd. follow to the end. Directly across from the stop sign you will see the North entrance to the Pony Club site. Enter into the field and proceed to top of hill and go thru second gate thru the woods into camp ground.

Coming across on the ferry?

Take I-5 north to the Mukilteo/Clinton ferry

Once off the ferry in Clinton follow Hwy 525 all the way up to Coupeville

At the Pedestrian over pass in Coupeville drive approx 4 more miles to Libby Rd.

Turn left on Libby Rd.

Turn right on West Beach Rd.

Turn right on Van Dam Rd. follow to the end. Directly across from the stop sign you will see the North entrance to the Pony Club site. Enter into the field and proceed to top of hill and go thru second gate thru the woods into camp ground.
